Contestant Judging Sheet

<u>Scoring Segment</u>	<u>Description</u>	<u>Points</u>
Me & My Heritage 20 Points	Recite an assigned speech that illuminates African Americans from our past and present.	
Dressy Dress (Poise & Presentation) 10 Points	Points will be based on confidence, appearance, and poise (CAP). All formal dresses must be pre-approved prior to the pageant. Tea length formal dress (1/4 -inch above ankle) to be worn by 6-yr-old contestants only — NO GOWNS!! Gowns must be worn all 7 – 12 year olds.	
Show & Tell 10 Points	Through personality, creativity, and spoken presentation each contestant will step into the future by creatively demonstrating their goals for their future and/or how they'd like to change the world. (Skit should be less than 2 minutes)	
Engagement & Participation 10 Points	Contestants cognitively engage and work purposefully and productively at workshops and rehearsals.	
Book Report 10 Points	Submit a book report based on contestant's assigned heritage person.
